## The Rockefeller University Rules and Guidelines for Bicycle Safety

While on University property, cyclists have all the rights and are subject to all of the duties and regulations applicable to drivers of motor vehicles and bicycle riders in NYC\*. The University reserves the right to establish additional and more stringent requirements for bicycle use on its properties.

## General rules:

- All riders are encouraged to wear a helmet. Cyclists under age 13 must wear an approved helmet.
- **Register your bicycle with Security**. This registration is required if you plan to park your bicycle for other than temporary, transient purposes.
- Park and secure your bicycle in the racks and stands made available by the University for bicycle parking. Do not bring your bicycle into University buildings. Do not secure your bicycle to building fixtures or facades. Bicycles found in unauthorized locations are subject to confiscation and removal by the University.
- **Temporary/Transient bicycle parking** is available only in the bicycle rack located by the 66<sup>th</sup> Street Gate.
- Ride in the vehicular roads on campus, not on the sidewalks or marble walkways and not in any interior spaces. Note: children age 12 or younger riding bicycles with wheels that are less than 26 inches in diameter may ride on sidewalks.
- Dismount and walk your bicycle on University sidewalks and the marble walkways.
- Ride with traffic, not against it.
- **Stop at red lights and stop signs**. Obey all traffic signals, signs and pavement markings, and exercise due care to avoid colliding with pedestrians, motor vehicles or other cyclists.
- Obey directions given by Security regarding use, parking or storage of your bicycle.
